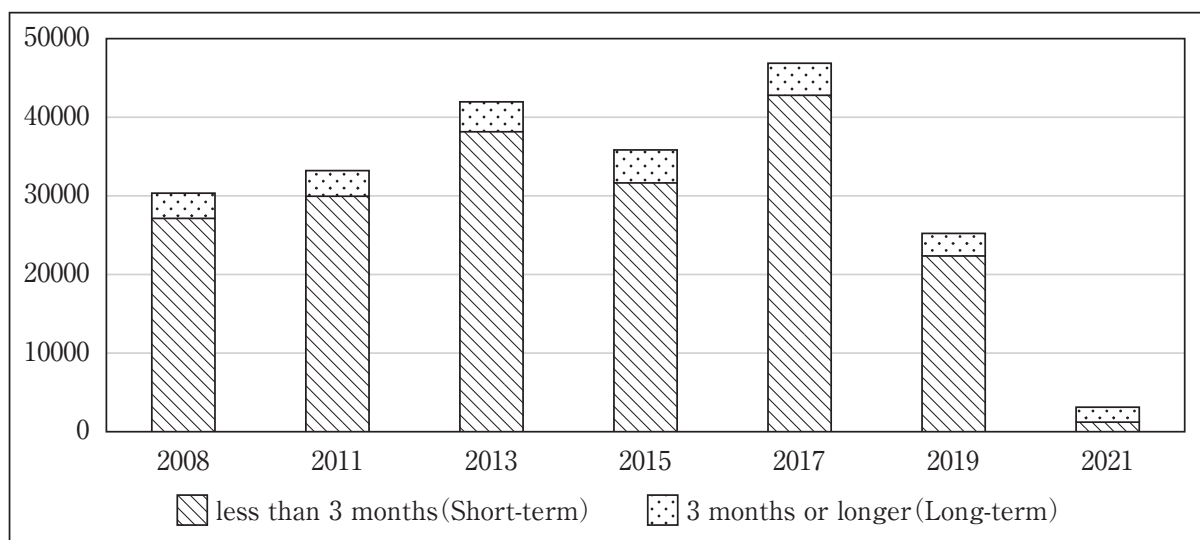


Ⅲ 次の英文を読んで、設問に答えなさい。

These days, studying in a foreign country is a popular choice for many Japanese high school students. Some schools and local governments have programs that they can join, too. They can choose to study from a few weeks to over a year. ( ① ) studying abroad, you can learn the language and culture of another country. You can also learn new ways of thinking. This can have a strong influence on yourself and on the people and the environment around you.

The beginning of Chuo University actually has a strong connection with studying overseas. It started with a group of eighteen young lawyers who got together to build a new school. Some of them had experience studying law in a foreign country. Rokuichiro Masujima was one of them. Rokuichiro was born in 1854. He was very smart as a child, and was also skilled in languages. After he graduated ( ② ) the University of Tokyo with top grades, he ③ (give) the chance to study in London with the support of Yataro Iwasaki, the well-known Japanese \*entrepreneur. In 1881, he became a student at a school of law called the Honourable Society of the Middle Temple. Two and a half years later, he graduated with the title of “Barrister at Law.” This was a title only for lawyers who would work in \*the upper courts. He worked for a \*law firm in England for one year before finally returning to Japan in 1884. Upon his return to Japan, he worked both as a lawyer and a teacher before he and his \*colleagues built ④ the “English Law School” (*Igirisu Horitsu Gakko*) the following year. Rokuichiro became the first principal of this school, and later, this school became known as Chuo University. It is fair to say that Rokuichiro’s international experience played an important role in the history of law and education in Japan.

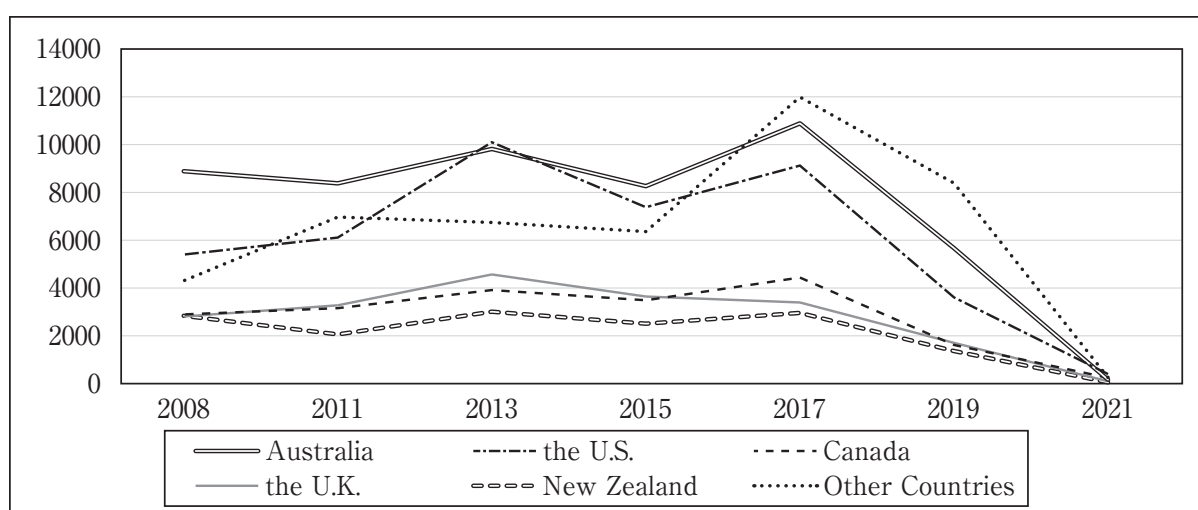

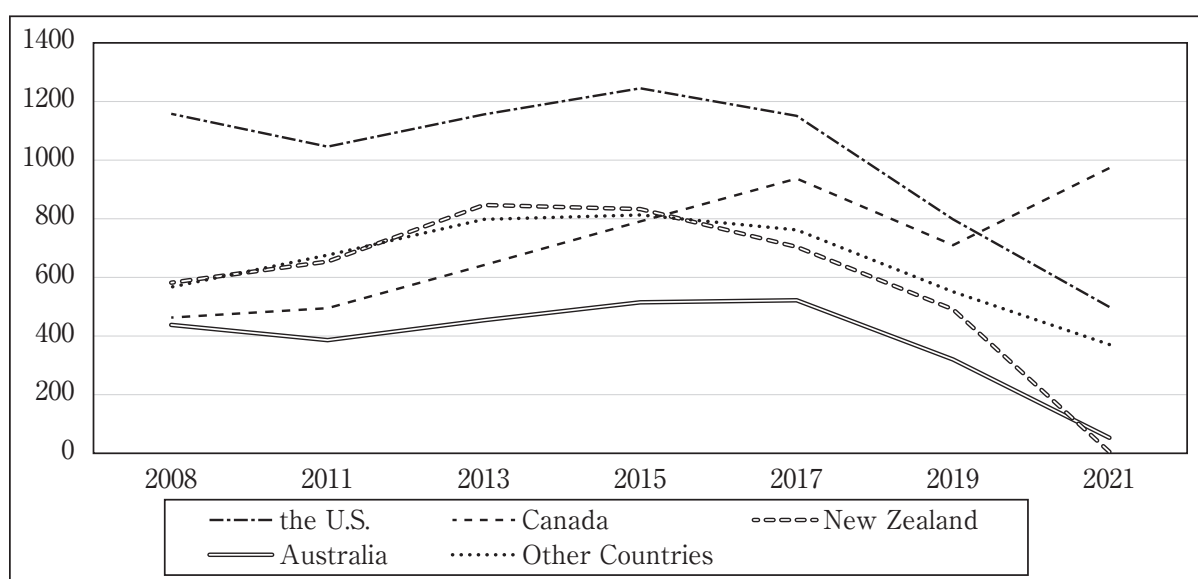
<Figure 1> The Number of Japanese High School Students Studying Abroad

Today, almost 140 years after Rokuichiro first traveled to England, there are a lot more Japanese people who study overseas. Studying abroad is now a popular choice, with many high school students looking to experience life in different countries. Here are some government data on Japanese high school students who studied abroad between 2008 and 2021. <Figure 1> shows the total number of students who have studied abroad. It shows that there are many more students who study ( ⑤ ). The figure shows that in

2019, there were ( ⑥ ) in 2017, and there were even less in 2021. However, ( ⑦ ) these numbers may not be completely correct due to the COVID-19 pandemic that hit the world; collecting data was difficult. It was a tough time for students who wanted to study abroad as they were not able to do so easily.

Here are two more figures that show countries where Japanese students chose to study between 2008 and 2021. <Figure 2> shows the data on students who studied on short-term programs. Before the influence of the pandemic, ( ⑧ ) was always one of the most popular destinations. However, in 2017, there was a sudden increase in students who wanted to travel to “other countries,” though ( ⑧ ) remained the most popular country to visit. <Figure 3> shows the same information on students who studied on long-term programs. Again, if we look at the data before the pandemic, many students chose the U.S. as their favorite place to study in. ( ⑨ ) is an interesting case. Numbers continued to rise until 2017, and they even rose again after 2019.

What should you do once you have decided to study abroad? The most important place to start is thinking about your goals. If you know your goals, you can think about how long you want to study for. It will also help you to choose which country you should study in. The next important thing is to learn

However, learning about your own country before you go can also be ( ⑪ ) learning about the country you will be studying in. For example, if you are an international student from Japan, you will probably have chances to introduce things about Japan while you are studying abroad. You will be able to achieve more by spending time learning about your own culture and history and collecting the latest information by reading the news. If you plan and prepare well, your experience abroad may be more \*rewarding.

In conclusion, studying abroad is now an experience which is chosen by many students. With careful planning, you can \*benefit from your time abroad even more. Your experience overseas may even be a valuable \*asset to your future career, and may even influence society in a ( ⑫ ) way, just like Rokuichiro's experience did.
